



School Uniform Policy

Tudhoe Colliery Primary School



Aim

Uniform is compulsory at Tudhoe Colliery Primary School. It is our policy that all children should wear clothing that is in keeping with a purposeful learning ethos.

We believe that wearing uniform encourages a sense of identification, equality, pride and a belonging to Tudhoe Colliery Primary School.

We also believe uniform should be practical, inclusive and affordable.

Uniform

- Red sweatshirt/cardigan
- White polo shirt
- Black or grey trousers
- Black or grey skirt/dress
- In the summer months a red gingham dress or grey/black shorts may be worn

School does not stock trousers/skirts/dresses etc - these can be purchased from the usual outlets. Please ensure your child wears suitable shoes for school.

Red sweatshirts/cardigans can be bought from any outlet. If you would like uniform embroidered with the school badge, this can be ordered from Elizabeths Embroidery: the details are available on the school website under 'Information for Parents.'

PE Kit

- Gym Shoes/trainers
- Shorts
- Vest or T- shirt

During the winter months a tracksuit may be advisable although not essential.

Please note that outdoor trainers should not be worn for indoor PE

- **NO JEWELLERY** other than stud earrings and analogue/digital watch/fitbit. Smartwatches are not permitted: no watch that is able to play games, send/receive calls or messages or take photographs is allowed in school.

We advise that your child does not come to school wearing any earrings on days when they will be doing PE or swimming. Children will not be allowed to take part in PE or swimming lessons if they are wearing earrings.

Please mark all items of uniform with your child's name.

It is very difficult to locate lost items when clothes are not named.
