This term, Year 5 are trying a new approach to reading and writing! We are following the Power of Reading approach.

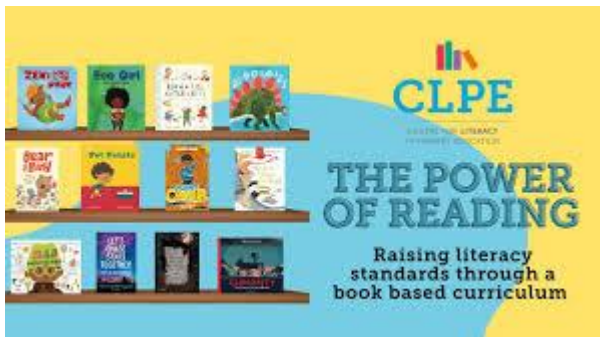


This approach involves

The wider curriculum at a glance...

In Geography, we will be comparing and contrasting different regions of China. We will examine living standards in different regions and what tourism opportunities China provides. We will link this to our previous topic of Biomes.

In History, we will study how early Islamic civilisations were formed and what attributes led to their successful implementation. We will also compare and contrast this to other periods in History we have studied.

In Science, we will be looking at Earth and Space. This will be the basis for our Spring educational visit. Additionally, we will be looking at classification in our Living Things topic.

During our RE unit, we will be learning about the Bible and its significance to Christians.
